Please join us in bringing a *permanent* end to chronic homelessness in Utah.

With your help, we have already made great strides towards this goal. About 500 apartments have been built in a revolutionary program that places homeless women, men and families in permanent supportive housing. The success is startling – 90% have stayed more than a year and are making remarkable advances in self-reliance. Space has been freed in our emergency shelters, and the public cost of emergency care for the homeless has decreased substantially.

The 1% Campaign is designed to answer Utah's *total* housing-for-the-homeless need, and to do so within 10 years. State-wide participation in one-time-only pledges, payable in easy installments, will fund construction and operation of the 2,500 supportive housing units needed to care for all chronically homeless in Utah.
